
HEALING HURTS: BEING SET FREE FROM STRONGHOLDS

TRUTH TO CAST DOWN LIES



God will forgive me.

I John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Psalm 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so far hath He removed our transgressions from us.
